The retaining wall on the top level is being rebuilt and additional terracing of the third level is contemplated. With upcoming City elections there is a heightened interest in government and politics running through the Village. The proposed expansion of Franklin Hospital with heliport and increased traffic is being vigorously opposed by neighborhood residents. Now the State Department of Health is considering whether the proposed additions to the hospital complex are really needed at all, and is holding a public hearing on the issue at McKinley School Auditorium on October 11 at 7 pm.

Siva Kalpa and Criminal Justice

Robert Straubmeier, known to us as Bob Moore (and euphemistically as "Bank Job Bob"), was sentenced here on October 6 to ten years in Federal Prison. The positive influence of the Foundation of Revelation helped reduce this sentence from a possible 65 years to a maximum of ten. Bob spoke about the extraordinarily positive effect upon him by the Foundation, and this evidence was taken into consideration by the court. Bob loves Father, and our continuing support will help his possibilities for early parole. Ernst Tibaldi, FBI agent assigned to this case, has assured me of our government's respect and appreciation of the Foundation's cooperation. The defense, parole and prosecuting forces, including the FBI, have the highest regard for our integrity. The case of Bruce Erickson is a study in contrast. His resistance to honest communication with the Foundation of Revelation, following his indictment on sale-of-narcotics charges, has inspired very limited help from us. Without judging the merits of either case, it should be made clear that those who love Father and communicate honestly will be assured of our support.

This shows the Power of Truth over falsehood. The Family supports the positive, and leaves non-sense to its own demise. As a personal message, I would like
