Father,*Anna Lynn, and the singing duo George and the Arizona Star left San Francisco in the afternoon taking the new interstate highway to Los Angeles, a seven-hour drive sonorous the whole time with rock music from the radio and George and Star working out their new compositions. The group arrived at Alan Schwarz's house in Bel Air at 10 p.m., and after George and Star changed their costumes they all went to dinner at the Bratskeller with Alan and Teddy Baron. They enjoyed a good dinner while exchanging news of the last few weeks and returned to Alan's where father and Anna Lynn retired and George, Star, Alan, and Teddy stayed up late talking.

THURSDAY, MARCH 23

Stuart Rice, Jr., son of the well-known diplomat and statistician of the same name, who filmed father's immigration case almost two years ago, came in the morning and joined everyone in poolside conversation. Two girls came, Monday and Kelly, a long-time friend of Alan's who had just finished a movie IOWA EXCHANGE, directed by Peter Fonda. Kelly and Monday, Alan, father, Anna Lynn and Monday's gigantic dog drove to the airport to meet Martin Magahy who was coming from London to rescue Tina and Philippa, then incarcerated in Sybil Brand Institute on smuggling charges. Father and Anna Lynn spent the afternoon with Martin. Many people came that night for a dual purpose, to see father and to attend a business meeting concerning Warren Stagg's 300-mile, 10-day march, the walkers to wear pyramids on their heads and fast, drinking only distilled water, a project intended to raise money to establish schools to teach various popular fads. Stuart Rice brought his friend John Barrymore, Jr. who was working hard at being an alcoholic and greatly enjoyed exchanging heated words with father and being told that he displayed none of the power of character that had made John Barrymore, Sr. a convincing Don Juan. Father went on to reveal at length that self-imposed suffering does not lead to knowledge and fulfillment and that purely physical efforts do not produce true spiritual advancement.

Restaurant and talked with some of the girls who had attended the meeting at Alan's, while Warren prepared his notes for a three-hour lecture he would deliver that afternoon to a national spiritual conference. When his notes were finished, he sat down to discuss his overwhelming financial straits and/the troubles of organizing his march, over cups of his delicious coffee. All were struck by Warren's sweetness and wondered how a man who sells food could profit by teaching fasting. They returned to Alan's with fresh strawberries from the Farmer's Market, and father told the story of the Mahabharata up to and including the first chapter of the Bhagavad Gita which Alan enjoyed with rapt attention. Star, for the first time on the trip, listened spellbound while George busied herself elsewhere. As the first chapter of Gita came to a close George entered and father brought up an earlier topic which had interested George, Why did Charles Manson kill? Because a few years ago everyone had murderous tendencies and Manson had freaked to the extent of manifesting his hostilities physically. George with an air of challenge denied ever being like that, only revealing that she still was. Father thundered on entertainers who dare to challenge an emperor on subjects about which they know nothing only resulting in the displeasure of the court leading to a speedy fall from appreciation in all circles. Music which distracts from the enjoyment of conscious existence has no value. On that note, father, Anna Lynn, and Martin left to pick up Ed Kahn at the airport, and when they returned they found that Michael Lagen, Tom Sumrall, and Reba Bowen

had stopped in on their return from New Mexico. What began as a chatty reunion developed into a dangerous situation as an unprepared Tom and Michael came into play with George's mounting hostility. Again father thundered on George, this time burning down sex which lacks heart and head. Everyone was shaken, as through the concrete example of George light was shed on very familiar contradictions. George and Star took a bus back to San Francisco that night, unable to bear any longer the company of those whose primary interest was truth.

While Ed and Martin were arranging for Tina and Philippa's release, father had a talk with Kelly assuring her that it was all right to follow her own feelings, that there was no sin, and that she needn't surrender to the momentary trips of her friends. Later Ed, Martin, father and Anna Lynn went to pick up Tina and Philippa and all together they went to Ed's favorite Mexican restaurant to celebrate a coming out party. They returned to find many people at Alan's assembled for another meeting to plan Warren's march. Everyone was waiting for Lee Galucci to arrive to lend psychic support to their efforts. By the time she did arrive Warren and company had decided not to convene but Lee stayed to be with father and to tease Martin and Alan. Shep and Tianne Sanders came from Palm Springs and invited several friends to come to meet father and everyone witnessed a Hollywood cocktail party.

TUESDAY, MARCH 28

Father, Anna Lynn and Ed visited Eugeny Osmond, a long-time friend of Ed's at her Art Moving and Storage Co., Cart and Crate, where business and Knowledge were discussed in an unhurried atmosphere. Father talked of solving problems, saying that once we know the principle by which one problem can be solved we can solve all problems. They returned to see Alan before he left for Hawaii and then went to visit Ed's sister Carolyn and brother-in-law Stan Goldberg. There father was received with great enthusiasm by Ed's two nieces, and while they kissed him and sang to him he explained to a questioning Stan that man had not created God. The evening continued at Alan's with Stan visiting and listening while Carolyn went to care for a suicidal friend.

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 29

Father, Anna Lynn, Ed, Martin, Tina, and Philippa went to see Squeak, one of Charles Manson's family, who had written to the Foundation in San Francisco. They were invited into the cluttered apartment by a congenial man who said Squeak was in the bathtub but we could wait. Squeak, a very sweet girl, talked and revealed much truth, but was confused as to what to do, seeing destruction as the only means of change. Only the Foundation of Revelation can relieve this confusion, and feeling this Squeak said she would visit San Francisco soon. They returned to Alan's to meet Larry Payne, editor of WHERE IT'S AT magazine, who listened throughout the afternoon and evening with child-like understanding and attention. He was excited about the idea of making his magazine a world-wide success with father's help and becoming a man who creates news rather that reporting it. He learned from father how to deal with his problems with his publisher and his girl friend and promised to come to San Francisco for further media revelations and to meet more of the family.

THURSDAY, MARCH 30

Everyone rose to clean house and finish a bottle of scotch before heading for San Francisco and home. Father and Anna Lynn took the commute flight and Ed, Tina, Philippa and Martin drove the Mustang, closing another saga produced on the screen of Hollywood consciousness.

APRIL 10 - MAY 7, 6TH YEAR SIVA KALPA, MINNEAPOLIS, ROCHESTER, BOSTON, NEW YORK CITY, PHILADELPHIA

MONDAY, APRIL 10

After a busy week of visiting and entertaining, father set off with Diana, Anita and Gordon for a grand tour of foundation families and friends across the country. Arriving late at the San Francisco International Airport with about fifty family members, they ran en masse with all the baggage to board their Northwest Orient champagne flight for Minneapolis at 8:45 a.m. The Minneapolis family had been organizing themselves to receive father for the past month and had presented the films CIRANJIVA and MAHAMILANA at the Walker Art Center on April 8 and at Mankato State College on April 9. Thirty-five members of the Minneapolis family gathered at the airport at 1:45 to receive father and his retinue with flowers, music, cameras, and a resounding BOM SHANKAR BHOLENATH. Amidst hugs and joyous greetings, Gordon was whisked away by four federal agents who mistook him for an international smuggler. Father told the agents to take good care of Gordon as a special request from their father and assured Gordon that they were nice gentlemen who meant him no harm. More family members were waiting to receive father at the foundation center on Nicollet Avenue South and after a brief visit across the street with Bob (the Boozer) Bonnyng who offered them Kool Aid, father and Diana joined the others. Father entertained the family at Nicollet with revelations about "feds without heads" who pervert the purpose of the F.B.I. by investigation without intelligence. In the evening, Nicollet was the scene of an elegant cocktail party for parents and friends of the foundation family, with Rolf Grudem's parents from St. Paul (where Mr. Grudem is superintendent of vocational schools), Tom Sharkey's parents who were in from Pennsylvania for an exhibition of his mother Kay's watercolors, one of which she presented to Nicollet house, his sister Karen and her baby son Satya, Sue Carpenter's aunt, Karlene Everson, and her friend Sharon Walsh, both active in local women's liberation politics. Also in attendance were Dr. Malcolm Moos, the controversial president of the University of Minnesota (under attack by the media for his overexpenditures on entertainment and travel) with his charming and beautiful wife Tracy, Dr. E. Ziebarth, Dean of the College of Liberal Arts at the University and his wife. Everyone exchanged stories and revelations in the warm atmosphere of love and understanding. Father chatted with Dr. Moos about their mutual friend Hale Champion whom father had met during his first trip to Minneapolis, but Dr. Moos beat a speedy retreat when father told him, "I may not know anything, but I have an infallible memory of everything that has happened. I worshipped American knowledge for forty-five years and I learned everything from you." Jan Stuurman, the public defender for Thom Hutchinson of the Minneapolis family, arrested for selling drugs to a federal agent, came later to the party with his lovely girlfriend Kathy, Father entertained him with a lengthy review of present practise of law, economics, politics, and administration revealing the truth behind these divisions of modern knowledge, and telling him, "I am kapo mafiosa, the godfather; keep your hands off my clan!" After the other guests departed and the family enjoyed a lasagna dinner prepared by Adriana Burck (Adi), Harold Kahm, author of a pornographic novel THE CROWDED BED and father's friend from his trip to Minneapolis last September arrived, congratulating father on his increasing youthfulness and telling of his new book THE LOVE BOMB about a being from outer space who attacks earthlings with a chemical to make them love each other. Harold and the family were treated to a slide show chronicling the movement of Siva Kalpa and the multiple activities of the Foundation of Revelation family.

TUESDAY, APRIL 11

Mary Albee and Rolf accompanied father, Anita and Diana to the State Courthouse to meet Emmanuel (Manny) Kopstein, a former prosecuting attorney who had volunteered to assist Gordon. Manny was late, so they wandered through the halls witnessing the creaky mechanism of the present legal system in several courtrooms, also reflected in the absence of ashtrays so as to maintain the job of sweeping away cigarette butts every few hours. Manny finally came and asked them to return after half an hour, so they left the Courthouse, admiring the huge statue of the god, Mississippi, which bore a striking resemblance to Gordon. They breakfasted at the Flour Exchange cafeteria and returned in time for Anita, father and Manny to visit Gordon, who reported the good effects of knowledge on the federal agents, the jailors, and his cellmate, a suspected murderer. They returned to Nicollet and left with Sue Carpenter and Tom Sharkey for KQRS, a popular radio station in nearby

Golden Valley where father was interviewed by Alan Stone, who manifested the same sweetness and divinity as the other Allan Stone who had interviewed father a few days after his arrival from India on KSAN in San Francisco. Father spoke about language as the medium for communication of truthful feeling, not for perversion as semantics and symbolism, and explained that Siva Kalpa is the fulfilment of all scriptures and the highest aspirations of mankind for the creation of a peaceful and happy world by revival of the language of truth. Before and after the broadcast they explained the practical application of Siva Kalpa to John Fineberg (Jonavan), the station's newest disc jockey. Adi, Mary, Rolf, Sue, Dick Voda, and Pam Schaeffers presented the films twice at the University of Minnesota to a delighted audience with the exception of about fifteen Indians who confronted them afterwards with a show of intellectual hostility. Ed Kahn arrived from San Francisco at Nicollet at IO:30 p.m., just in time for a family birthday party in honor of Meredith Wasmund and Shelby Brewer. Father held all the boys entranced during a two-hour standing duni, then moved through the ecstatic crowd of family members worshipping each one. The guests dispersed around I p.m. but father entertained the few survivors until 4.

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 12

A large group of family members spent the day at St. Cloud, 80 miles from Minneapolis. The films were shown twice at the State College, where father had spoken in November of 5th year, and family members, new and old, enjoyed a picnic and party at "Maggie's Farm", a Siva Kalpa outpost headed by Jeff Sharkey. Father did not go since the preliminary hearing to set bail for Gordon's release was held at IO a.m. The courtroom was tranced by the presence of the creator of law and his gods and goddesses. The court from judge to bailbondsman revealed that their purpose was to make money not to administer justice, but they could not hide their innate sweetness and good humor. Thom and Gordon were released and everyone passed the rainy afternoon at Nicollet listening to father. Tony Kalar, excited by hearing father's revelations on radio, came with tape recorder and open ears. Father wiped out Zen Buddhism for the evolution of Joel Figen, a new family member, who was suffering an enforced aspiration for nothingness. In the evening the family gathered to relate their experiences at St. Cloud and to listen to knowledge.

THURSDAY, APRIL 13

The preliminary hearing on the charges against Gordon and Thom was held at II a.m. in the federal courthouse. James Mac Dowell, a very sweet narcotics agent who had arrested Thom, presented his testimony with many inconsistencies and memory lapses. They left the judge and his court pondering the meaning of Siva Kalpa and purusing the papers of the Foundation of Revelation. In the afternoon they visited John Fineberg at his home near Lake of the Isles and made a leisurely tour of the famous Minneapolis lakes which were still covered by a thin layer of ice. Back at Nicollet they found a roomful of ready listeners and father got into high revelations tracing the involution of knowledge into its various refractions as philosophical egos of the past. At dusk they moved to Blaisdell Avenue house where Thom, Suzanne and Sue were hosting Jan Stuurman and Kathy for cocktails. Father continued his revelations, tracing law back to its origins in the Bible and ancient Sanskrit scriptures and telling Jan that the issue at hand was not the possession of drugs, but the possession of their minds by truth. After cocktails, thirty family members gathered for dinner, reports of the film showings to three classes on "The Religion Revolution" at Lakewood Junior College, a Lutheran school in Stillwater, and a wonderful evening of revelations, stories and chanting.

FRIDAY, APRIL 14

Meredith drove father, Diana, Anita, Gordon and Ed to meet Sally Irvine, Shotsy's aunt, at her home in St. Paul, where they delighted her with a presentation of California artichokes and San Francisco sourdough bread, and then moved on to the elegant Minnesota Club. They were joined for cocktails by Sally's son Jock, George Schaefer, manager of the St. Paul Opera Association, and other friends for an hour of lively conversation before lunch. Sally was full of praise for her niece and was thrilled to hear more about Shotsy's role as the beginner of the Foundation of Revelation. Back at Nicollet they found the living room packed with family and new friends. All listened with rapt attention as father spoke. Alan Stone arrived in time for the slide show, narrated by father. After a hasty dinner, the evening continued with a visit from Dr. Ahlstrom, the Lutheran minister-philosophy teacher whose classes had seen the films the day before. Father revealed himself to the delighted Dr. Ahlstrom as the destroyer of all institutional divisions of truth and outlined

the decline of Christianity as the corruption of the Catholic Church engendered the Protestants whose continuing protests divided humanity more and more.

SATURDAY, APRIL 15

The day began with a waffle breakfast prepared by Meredith. Two cars full of family members gathered for a caravan to Minnehaha Falls where father took movies. Then they drove through the university neighborhood and saw in many store windows beautiful posters of father and Visnu designed to announce the films. After a stop for hamburgers and a supply of Grain Belt beer, they visited the beautiful conservatory at Como Park in St. Paul and gathered on a hillside for a beer and more filming. Once again they returned to a crowded living room of beautiful forms. Father entertained the group with stories of the Golden Age and everyone could feel that it was indeed being revived. Manny Kopstein arrived several hours late for his appointment with father and was entertained in the kitchen while Diana talked to the family in the living room about the importance of self respect. Father revealed himself as Justinian and as Manu, the lawgiver for the modern and the ancient times, with full knowledge of what goes on behind the closed doors of a travesty of justice. He assured Manny that there was more than enough money to relieve his preoccupation with lawyer's fees but that if he didn't listen to the truth he would lose his ability to enjoy what he had gained. Father left with Anita, Gordon, Ed, Thom and Suzanne for dinner at the well-known Harry's Steakhouse and made friends with many of the other diners, while Diana entertained a gathering of goddesses at Nicollet with stories of the evolution taking place among the family in San Francisco. The gods, meanwhile, gathered at Scott Hanson's house for an evening of communication and fun. Father and the others returned in high spirits to play with the goddesses and babies before retiring.

SUNDAY, APRIL 16

Father rose early to write postcards to India describing the success of divine knowledge in America. About twenty family members gathered for coffee before setting off to the airport. Ed departed at noon for San Francisco, and father entertained the large crowd of family with revelations in the middle of the airport until their departure at I2:45. A young man from the Campus Crusade for Christ passed by the group and then returned to declare that the Lord had told him to go back and speak. After a few sentences which were received with smiles and nods of agreement, he realized that he had nothing to say. They flew to Rochester and were received by an ecstatic group of family members most of whom were seeing father for the first time. They were driven to the foundation headquarters at Genesee Park Blvd., the home of Eric and Abigail Eiger who met father in San Francisco during 4th year with their baby daughter Lakshmi and Charles and Judy Pixley. After a feast of Italian cold cuts and a short rest, the living room filled up with people eager to know more about Siva Kalpa and the activities of the Foundation of Revelation. Diana and Gordon read letters describing the profound effects of the Indian family in America and told stories about the gods and goddesses in San Francisco. One of the girls there, Julie Babb, revealed herself as a childhood friend of Bronwyn Davis and Ricardo Frohmater, and another girl, Jude Buckman, told how she just missed meeting father in New Orleans last fall, only to find him in Rochester, proving that the planet is indeed a small area in the immensity of cosmic imagination.

MONDAY, APRIL 17

The group rose early and drove to WROC-TV and Radio to meet interviewer Tom Ryan who did a newspot with father, followed by a half-hour interview for his show Crossfire. Midway he said, "Well there isn't much crossfire today. I just can't disagree with anything you say." Infected by the cynicism of media, he was reluctant to admit that America is the chosen land to lead the world to a higher level of existence, but he could not deny the infallible logic of the will of Time. At noon they moved on to Monroe Community College where Judy read Siva Kalpa to a gathering in the auditorium, and then the group moved out to the Student Union plaza where Diana read Astrology and father described the four types of knowledge, occult knowledge achieved through a feeling of identity with the object of cognition, knowledge by observation and analysis, knowledge through the media of another person's viewpoint, and mechanical recording of informations devoid of feeling or understanding. He applied this division to the four types of scientists. The late afternoon was spent shopping with Eric and Abigail. Back at the house they listened to beautiful music by Charley

(on flute) and Mark Grigajtis (formerly with the House of Ahz in San Francisco) on guitar. The evening brought a huge gathering of angels, mostly friends of Debbie Holmes, a powerful goddess attending the University of Rochester. They were entertained by father thundering on the idols of dead intellect enshrined in the disintegrating institutions of so-called learning. The household retired after a delicious midnight supper of orangini, an old Italian dish Abigail had learned from her grandmother.

TUESDAY, APRIL 18

The day began with a visit to WHEC-TV where father was interviewed after the news by Warren Doremus and Eddy Meath. He told the story of his life in India, his early rejection of the decadence of his aristocratic background, his scientific atheism, business career, and his return to God in 1964 leading to the comprehensive vision of the new time of Siva Kalpa in 1966. He explained the Real Idea of reintegrated orders of existence as the understanding that everything is being done by God not by the puny activities of our egos. Their final question was about "family", and he responded that the family is the whole existence; worship of God is taking care of the family, and the breakdown of the family which we witnessed in recent times is more tragic than wars or natural disasters. After the interview the group breakfasted at Howard Johnson's, and father talked about movies of the past and present pointing out the vast difference between the art of apprehension and the art of knowledge. Back at the house Eric read from the Mahabharata, a long section at the end of the Drona Parva, extolling and describing Siva, to which father replied "Vyasa tried to explain me in so many words and divisions, but here I am so simple like a baby, and the document of Siva Kalpa in only one page sums up the entire Mahabharata." In the evening they entertained Judy's parents and younger sister, and later many students and friends enjoyed father's narration of the slide show.

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 19

Father prepared a delicious breakfast of jam omelets for everybody, and Diana, Anita and Gordon went through the files of the Rochester foundation realizing the importance of more and better communication among all centers of the foundation family. They piled into Charley's Country Squire station wagon and set off for Niagara Falls with father in high revelations on the nature of Siva. As father chanted the first three chapters of Gita, Charley went deeper and deeper into trance until Eric shouted for his attention to the road and the ravine towards which the car was heading. Father stopped chanting and switched his revelations to food and recipes. The falls, a truly great experience, were enjoyed from several views, and movies and slides were taken. After coffee and choosing postcards to send to India they drove to Goat Island for a view of the Canadian Horseshoe Falls. The island was shrouded in fog, but they had a friendly chat with the policeman there and father posed for a picture in front of a monument dated 1966. They stopped for dinner at Page's, Home of the Whistle Pig, and father busily wrote postcards to India before and after the meal. Back in Rochester they were greeted by Jamie, a sweet friend of the family, who was concerned about Debbie, whom he said had "flipped up." Everybody piled into the car to visit Debbie at the Steak and Brew where she works part-time as a cocktail waitress. Debbie was delighted to see them, and the presence of so many ecstatic forms was felt by the entire restaurant. Ray Dunlap, the pianist-singer for the evening, got into the feeling immediately and began changing his lyrics to suit the occasion. What started out as "Lola's Back in Town" became "Father's Back in Town" and was repeated several times as a sing-along. At a high point, Judy took the microphone and sang to Ray's accompaniment "Has Everybody Seen My Lord?" All joined in in the fun except two dropouts from happiness who sat whispering and pointing from the bar. Before leaving father thundered at them "I'm God. Do you doubt my power to assume one of your forms?" to the applause of the rest of the patrons.

THURSDAY, APRIL 20

The morning was spent discussing the pragmatic organization of the family and foundation and listening to father. During a trip to the laundramat and grocery store they met an Indian lady, Lakshmi Mani, who had seen father on TV and directed them to a Chinese store to purchase Indian spices for the evening meal. Family and friends gathered at the house in the late afternoon, and Gordon entertained them with stories and slides while father and Diana prepared an Indian dinner. After dinner father entertained a small gathering of the household plus Debbie. Tim, Jude, Harry, Bea & Bob, taking each one aside for personal revelations while Gordon and Diana talked with the others.

FRIDAY, APRIL 21

The day was spent at home entertaining a steady stream of visitors. Father made delicious omelets for household and guests and wrote postcards to India explaining that acceptance of Siva Kalpa by Americans overwhelmingly compensates for its rejection by its cradle creating two poles of increasing happiness and suffering as the reward and punishment for understanding and rejection. The landlord dropped in for a visit and complimented father on his TV broadcast. Father entertained the gathering in the evening by singing and translating Bengali songs and describing the vast differences between Sakti Kalpa and Siva Kalpa. He got into revelations on entomology describing the life span of a bee hive with the Queen Bee pitted against her princess daughters surrounded by their drones, a process ending either in death or in escape to build a new colony. But without ego humanity can organize itself much more divinely that that.

SATURDAY, APRIL 22

The morning was spent packing while father made jam omelets for everyone. At the airport Jude Buckman who works for Avis Rent-A-Car presented father with a "We Try Harder" button, pointing out that Avis is Siva spelled backwards. Their flight for Boston was delayed for nearly two hours so they graced the airport bar with their happy presence and listened to father's stories about the beginnings of Siva Kalpa in India and the arrival of the Westerners in 1968. In Boston they took a taxi to Lois Litwack's apartment in Kenmore Square near Boston University and Northeastern University where Lois and her roomates are students. Lois had learned of Siva Kalpa last fall through John Morton of the Paris family and has been corresponding with Gail Cohen in San Francisco. They went out to explore the neighborhood and talked with an Indian engineer and his American wife who were bemoaning the difficulty of finding jobs in America. Back at the apartment Diana talked with Lois, her roomate Connie and Connie's friend Gordon, an aspiring intellectual. Gordon asked Diana for a definition of thought concepts, and she explained how the Real Idea of Creation possessed the forms of the goddesses for the conception of the Foundation of Revelation. After the reading of all the foundation papers, Gordon and Connie continued to challenge with quotes from books they had read. Lois's sister Nancy arrived and instantly melted into smiles and giggles while Gordon and Connie left to pursue their intellectual conversation. Two sweet neighbors Jim and Paul dropped in and loved father's personality, but couldn't listen to his knowledge.

SUNDAY, APRIL 23

After breakfast the group set out to explore the city. Intrigued by the "Science Park" station on the subway map they found themselves in the Museum of Science and Natural History where they saw relics of space ships, stuffed animals and Birds, mechanical replicas of the human heart, and a show called "Transparant Woman". Back at the house they found that Lois was feeling confused by her friends' resistances to happiness and knowledge so father started explaining to her, Connie and Nancy how resistances and contradictions maintain the time and prove the power of knowledge to overcome them. Another roomate Marilyn returned, and Jim, Bill Kelly, and others came to see father. Jim provoked many revelations on health and dis-ease by chiding father for smoking cigarettes, and Connie's question "do you believe in reincarnation?" brought forth the revelation that knowledge requires understanding, not belief, and then an explanation of how knowledge incarnates itself according to the needs of the time. As Jim and Connie kept insisting that they couldn't understand, father pointed out how simple Siva Kalpa is compared to any intellectual construction of the past. After the slides were shown, Bill revealed his growing understanding and enjoyed listening to the CIRANJIVA transcript. Gordon, Anita, and Diana went out for pizza and met a beautiful waitress Kathy while father talked to Lois.

MONDAY, APRIL 24

They spent the morning walking around Boston University and looking for a copy of Horizon Magazine which carried a picture story of the Foundation of Revelation in its spring issue. They found no Horizon, but witnessed the rising tension among the students over the resumed bombings in Vietnam and various local issues of contention before walking over to Richard and Betty Burdick's flat on Bay State Road overlooking the Charles River. They were greeted by Betty and exchanged stories about their daughter Dorene, her husband Chittraratha, their baby son Surya, and other members of the San Francisco family, and about Richard's new job as general manager of WCVB-TV, Boston's Channel 5.

They took a cab to the airport to receive Shotsy who arrived with letters and stories about the family in San Francisco. Richard returned from work in the early evening and listened to stories about the Spiritual Summit Conference and the origins of the Foundation of Revelation. Richard asked whether father had planned for the foundation to be composed only of goddesses or if it just happened that way to which father replied, "Nothing happens unless I plan it, but it also happened that way. All the gentlemen at the Spiritual Summit Conference were afraid of me, but all ladies love me." Richard asked father to clear up his contradictions about money and father assured him that nothing is bad when it is used with a purpose. Richard set off to tape an editorial on cleaning up the polluted Charles River, and Betty treated the group to a delicious Bostonian dinner. When Richard returned, they all enjoyed the slide show before retiring.

TUESDAY, APRIL 25

They spent a leisurely morning helping Betty evaluate the controversial A to Zenker talk show on Channel 5 which featured the "Happy Hooker" and some advocates of group sex. Afterwards, father translated the song "Hara, hara Sankara", invoking Siva to remove darkness and ignorance from the world and destroy the triple city of spiritual, academic and political perversion by the flow of knowledge. This led to a story about Siva's appearance disguised as a decadent gentleman at a council of the gods, who undermined him for his appearance and manner until he suddenly disappeared leaving them scratching their heads in amazement, and then a recounting of the Kena Upanishad. They spent the afternoon at Harvard and witnessed the grotesque deformities produced by intellectual preoccupations along with political demonstrations. They discovered that Hale Champion, vice president for financial affairs, whom they were to visit had gone to Europe to elude the demonstrators insisting that the university sell its shares in military industries. In the evening Lois, Connie, Nancy, her friend Alan, and Jeff Morris, who had met father in San Francisco in 4th year, gathered at the house with Richard and Betty. Father had a conference with Richard about the use of media while Gordon and Diana talked with Betty in the kitchen and the others talked and listened to the tape of San Francisco family musicians. After the guests had departed father chanted 11th chapter Gita and reminded the family of the seriousness of their purpose in removing ignorance from the suffering existence.

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 26

In the morning father chanted Gita, chapters 8-11, explaining the universal form and the immutable form which lies behind it. He and Shotsy spent the afternoon visiting cousin Sandy, Sally Irvine's daughter-in-law. Diana spent the day talking with Lois about the process of personal evolution. The evening was set aside for Richard and began with the tape of Gordon and father interviewed by the hostile radio ego of Jim Harper in Miami - a powerful revelation for media men. Then Dick expressed some worry about Dorene's future and was reassured by all. After dinner, father agreed to appear Friday on the A to Zenker Show, and they got into revelations on the greatness of America.

THURSDAY, APRIL 27

The day was spent writing postcards to India and to the family in San Francisco and talking with Lois. Richard and Lynn Becker, cousins of Joanne Hamilton, arrived for cocktails, a reading of the foundation papers, and revelations on how to experience the existence of God. Later many friends gathered at the house. Diana talked with Richard, relieving some of his confusions about father and telling him the story of her first contact with the divine family. After a delicious roast beef dinner and lots of laughter, the group retired.

FRIDAY, APRIL 28

They rose early, packed, exchanged loving goodbyes with Betty, and set off with Richard and Lois for the station. They had coffee with the small audience of the A to Zenker Show and T. George Harris, editor of Psychology Today Magazine, the other guest on the show. Shotsy found her old school friend Townie Starr, who had met father at Margo Warnecke's party on Russian River, working at the station as a writer. Arnold Zenker revealed himself as a very sweet man and father told about his life before Siva Kalpa, his worship of America, and his meeting with the West at the Spiritual Summit Conference in 1968. Shotsy and Diana described their recognition of father's absolute knowledge and power as the solution for all problems. T. George Harris demonstrated psychological games and tried to psychoanalyze Shotsy, Diana, and father by the clothes they were wearing. After the show they toured part of the station and met several of

the happy and personable staff members before driving to the airport for the flight to New York City. Father and Shotsy passed the time in a lively conversation with a black lady singer. Arriving at La Guardia they took a cab to the Tudor Hotel on 42nd Street two blocks from the United Nations, and started telephoning friends to arrange their schedule. They enjoyed a dinner and walk in Chinatown and had a good talk with two Jesus freaks.

SATURDAY, APRIL 29

Gordon and Anita visited Central Park, while father, Shotsy, and Diana went for luncheon with Carroll Stuchell, one of the Temple of Understanding tour members who had met father in Calcutta. She was relieved to learn that her guests preferred scotch to herb tea and immediately confessed that she had dropped out of the Temple of Understanding because of the lack of agreement and the inanity of their projects. She had a copy of Horizon Magazine and they laughed over the contrast between the foundation picture story and the other entries in the "Gallery of Gurus". After a delicious luncheon, Carroll listened attentively to a reading of the foundation papers. Her only question was "How do you put it into practice?" which was answered by Shotsy's description of a typical day at Scott Street. She raised the subject of donations, and father told her to use her money to come visit the family in San Francisco. In the evening they went to Shotsy's cousin Penny MacSweeney's apartment for cocktails. On the way they had a blissful encounter with a sweet couple and their baby Jason who looks just like Shotsy's son Skanda, with everyone taking pictures. Father entertained and worshipped Penny and her boyfriend Floyd. Back at the hotel they met a Punjabi, Surjit Bakshi, assistant director of the Indian Tourist Office. They invited him to their room, and father immediately began revealing himself in Sanskrit and English as Siva, thundering the destruction of the ignorant existence of the Indian educated class and government. Surjit listened to all the foundation papers, nodding in agreement at every line. As he left he asked father if he was going to destroy all the Indians to which father replied "How can I destroy my cradle? The grassroots Indians who love and understand me are saved."

SUNDAY, APRIL 30

After breakfast they saw Shotsy off at Grand Central Station for New Canaan, Connecticutt to visit her relatives the Livingstons, parents of Patty who accompanied Shotsy and the others to the mud hut in Gorkhara. Father wrote postcards to India while Anita had a long phone conversation with Ramona Levitt, formerly of the San Francisco family, helping her to overcome her unhappiness and inviting her to visit that evening. Then Debbie Holmes from Rochester called from her parents home in New Jersey where she was attending her sisters wedding and came to the hotel within two hours, with reports of growing love and understanding among the Rochester family. Shotsy was late so Gordon called the Livingstons who were bubbling with praise for Shotsy's happiness and charm. Shotsy arrived soon after, and they departed for dinner with Ramona and Debbie at Howard Johnson's, regaled by the Punjabi bartender Shelly Bhumitra and the other waiters. Back at the hotel they entertained a very happy Nick Polites and his friends Alan and Bill with the slide show, the readings, and revelations until 2.

MONDAY, MAY 1

They had lunch on Wall Street with Peter Cohan (Coyote) former hippie guru, who took over his father's investment firm to pay off the mortgage on the family farm in Pennsylvania where he lives with his followers. Throughout the lunch Coyote expounded on his theories about the current situation in America. He was invited for an evening visit at the hotel. On their way back they were splattered with mud by a passing car, as a gift from Wall Street. Gordon and Anita entertained Arthur Lisch, a friend of Ron and Marsha Thelin, while father, Shotsy, and Diana went for tea with Tillie Pabst in her new apartment in the United Nations Plaza. Tillie revealed that she had resigned as chairman of the Friends of the Temple of Understanding because the Temple had become nothing but an ego trip, generating misunderstanding. They discussed the importance of family as the basis for any larger unity, and father and Tillie compared their experiences of death (both at the age of 28) and being pulled back by the heartfelt cries of their parents and children respectively. On their way to cocktails with Liz and Fernanda, old school friends of Shotsy, they ran into Gordon and Anita's old friend Helen, just back from India, with praise for the grassroots Indians who had worshipped her as a goddess. They found a roomfull of people at the party - Liz with her baby daughter Diana, Liz's mom, Mrs. Prinz, Fernanda's boyfriend Frank who had met father at Nick

Polites' apartment the year before, and two big game hunters from Kenya - with several conversations going on at once. All had seen the Horizon Magazine and were eager to know more about the foundation. Father entertained them, moving from group to group, and part of the foundation papers were read. They found Coyote waiting for them back at the hotel. Debbie arrived soon after and they listened to the CIRANJIVA transcript and the tape of Walter Steven's Fairy Tale for the Children of the Forties and Fifties. While the musical tape was playing, Coyote talked about his hippy days, and father snored on the bed. Shotsy asked Coyote about his mother with whom he stays week-nights, and he replied that she was unhappy but there was nothing he could do to help.

TUESDAY, MAY 2

Shotsy and father had morning coffee with Father John C. Haughey, the Jesuit priest who presided over the Spiritual Summit Conference in Calcutta. Father brought up the subject of the Pope buying poverty-striken girls from India for use as nuns in Italy. Father Haughey reported that a special commission had investigated and found no evidence, but as the discussion went on, complete agreement was reached, with Father Haughey referring to the Pope as "a personality without love". Shotsy telephoned Judith Hollister, chairman of the Temple of Understanding, to cancel their appointment for tea and reported on the work of the foundation to which Judy replied "We're on the same path, but maybe we're going in different directions." Anne Parkinson, the first Westerner father met at the Spiritual Summit Conference came for a meeting in the hotel pub. Father reminded her of the details of their encounter in Calcutta, and Shotsy told the story of the conception and growth of the Foundation of Revelation. Anne said fond goodbyes to "Eternal" (her name for father) and danced out of the hotel. They went for cocktails at the apartment of Kathy and Bernie Walters, old friends of Diana, read them the foundation papers and answered their many questions. Then on for a dinner-party at the apartment of Jeff Gates, a friend of Nancy Sloan. Father revealed himself as Siva to the gathering of young sophisticates, who were amazed by the vitality and intelligence of the gods and goddesses.

WEDNESDAY, MAY 3

Jim Russell of the San Francisco family, then visiting his parents in New York, came to the hotel with his sister Pat, and drove the group to the airport to see Shotsy off for San Francisco. In the afternoon father was interviewed by Bonita Fury on the Sound and Fury Show at WRVR-Radio. He revealed that yoga is not physical exercise or diet, but the working out of the principle that maintains the bodies, the impulse of the mental being. Physical practices may succeed for a time by autosuggestion, but only communication with knewledge can effect a permanent transformation. After the broadcast they travelled through the pouring rain to meet Robert's dad Irving Mandel at the Steak and Brew. Father got into revelations on chemistry before Irving arrived, and then the mood switched to jokes and storytelling. Father told him that money is to serve us not to enslave us and assured him that Robert would become rich enough to take good care of him. Father made friends with all the other people in the bar before embarking on a magical bus ride laughing and talking with all the other riders. In the evening they went with Surjit to a party at the studio of photographer Gilles Larrain, arranged by Nick Polites. Father played with Gilles' young daughter Oliviette, finding most of the party resistant to knowledge. Finally the slides were projected with a powerful commentary by father. Midway Gilles asked them to stop so he could show his slides of costumed and painted forms, a grotesque travesty of humanity in revealing contrast to the forms of the divine family.

THURSDAY, MAY 4

At midday they set off for Penn Station and a wonderful train ride to Philadelphia. They were met by Judy Meltzer and Karen Capone, cousins of Hari, Rich, and Mel Meyers, and driven to Karen and Pat's lovely home in Overbrook Park. Faye, mother of the Meyers clan, came for a visit, asking about the family in San Francisco whom she and her husband Bob had met during their visit several weeks before. Father made an Indian dinner for the gathering of Pat and Karen, Judy and her children Tracy and Joel, and Lois, Chip and their baby son Justice. After dinner, father talked about the process of re-evolution leading us back to the Golden Age.

FRIDAY, MAY 5

In the morning father explored the neighborhood to the delight of schoolchildren who couldn't decide if he was Santa Claus or Uncle Sam. Relatives came for

visits all afternoon, each exclaiming to father that he looked even younger and healthier that the year before. There were many revelations on the condition of dis-ease which produces physical suffering and the contradictions of the medical profession which thrives on sickness. After a delicious dinner of brisket provided and carved by Bob Meyers, family and friends gathered for the musical tape, slide show, and revelations.

SATURDAY, MAY 6

Karen took her guests on a delightful tour of Philadelphia in full glory of springtime with cherry blossoms, azaleas, and tulips everywhere. They visited Independence Hall, the hippy area, and drove along the Schuylkill River. Anita visited Faye, Mitzi, Florence, and Rose, the four aunts, and talked to them about the practical application of father's power to solve all problems. Father and Diana prepared an elegant Indian dinner after which father entertained Karen and Pat, Judy and Denny, Lois and Chip, with revelations on language and grammar, describing the eight parts of speech, and the difference between scripture, truth written in script, and fiction, which is the projection of ephemeral individual desire.

SUNDAY, MAY 7

They rose early and drove to the airport with Karen, Judy and Tracy. They were greeted in San Francisco by over 100 ecstatic family members, gracing the airport once again with a flood of love and laughter.

The day continued with father revealing his kingly nature to an amazed hall of diners at Sherman's Delicatessen. The two hour drive back to Alan's filled the desert night with thunderous revelations shaking the fetters of inertia.

THURSDAY, MAY 18

Morning brought Andrew, Blue and Bob from their commune, the Sananda Foundation in Santa Cruz, who joined Alan, Don, father and Shotsy for breakfast out, returning to find Bob Shapiro, executive vice president of Home Savings and Loan Association, waiting for father's reassuring revelations to big business. All laughed a lot and Bob left feeling very happy, In the afternoon Alan and Shotsy enjoyed tennis while movies were made and photos snapped. Brenda, a black folk singer who had met father and Shotsy on the plane between Boston and New York in April, came with her roomate Beverly. In the late afternoon Alan, father and Shotsy went to see Marsha, Alan's ex-wife, to pick up Michael, Jill, Kathy and Karen, their children, for dinner at the Copper Penny. The trio returned the children to their mother and back to Alan's to encounter a huge party including many old acquaintances as Carla and Brett from Santa Barbara, Kristin and Tanden, teenage songwriters and their friend Brian Jones of the Beach Boys, to witness father as Pancho Villa. Then they enjoyed an elegant vegetarian banquet prepared by Teddy.

FRIDAY, MAY 19

People always get serious when they try to explain or advocate something they don't really understand or feel. But I'm sure you must have felt that's not the way it ought to be. In SIVA KALPA, yoga is defined as "the purposeful life of the self-conscious man". Literally yoga means union, and the primary union is between the mind, the heart and the body--all reflecting the same divine consciousness. On a grander scale yoga is the union of matter and spirit or the materialization of divine knowledge as the creation of heaven on earth. The aspiration for this union of matter and spirit is what gives life its purpose. Yoga starts with the individual reintegrating the dismembered parts of his existence by remembering the unity of life, mind, and matter he experienced as a small child. Buddha spent so much time pondering over right attitude and wrong and getting caught in his own labyrinth of the eightfold path that he failed to manifest any will. Instead he judged himself so severely that he imagined legions of Wrathful Deities to maintain his inertia of suffering and hostility. You see he never resolved his contradictions and so naturally his doctrine degenerated through a succession of translations. Compassion got lost in pity, dharma or duty became a means of self-abnegation. The principle of unattachment was expressed as exclusive attachment to the unmanifest and the unborn. This lead the mind into consider indiscriminate nature and the agnostic conclusions of relativity and impermanence. You created a void of imagination. A state of ignorance and not of release. Buddhists explore this night of negative consciousness calling it Nirvana, using the unique method of forgetfullness to achieve the illusion of possessing truth. A sense of humor may have redeemed you from your slumbering trance.

Gautama Buddha was surely the light of Asia in a negative period that experienced matter as bondage and correlated redemption with release from the needs of the body. Matter and spirit were viewed as so divided that intuitions of supraphysical existence failed to gain knowledge in body. So the wandering Buddha, neglecting to awaken his own family, could not reproduce his consciousness in a single other form. All alone selfishly marooned in his Bardo he was afraid to recognize time. Time meant movement, change from the unconditioned state a need to communicate to a physical world. His apprehension of time maintained a tension in the form of successive Buddhas. This stubborn mental stasis, ceasing to recognize the purpose of time, failed to project anything beyond Buddha's initial illumination.

So the light of Asia never grew out of its infancy of the negative way.

Visions under the bodhi tree, in caves, in monastic dungeons produced only a severe picture of a static conditioned cosmos. Time is now releasing you from your obscure perceptions. As creation moves forward towards its own fulfillment your futile prayer wheels, mantras, mandalas and monasteries fall further into the background. A positive vision is born. Old Buddha has earned his sleep after all he was the Father of Night.

A real Father creates light. He teaches his children to project their infinite light and will into the conditions of space and time. Such a Father is here. A radiant light. Ciranjiva. When you can learn the true meaning of His name perhaps your defeatism will end. You see the real idea of creation is no longer an abstraction. Father creates events in the imagination which materialize in our feelings. Remember feelings? Could your old weary hearts come out from the monasteries of intellect perhaps your Old Master could regain his smile. Because what Buddha suffered as contradictions our Father enjoys as complements of the evolution. Buddha was a part of this evolution, a moment of the will to enlighten, which failed to effectuate itself in a process called time. He tried to reach the end all of a sudden, forgetting the will that held his form in existence. So death came to the prince of darkness leaving as an epitaph an opaque memory of God, inexplicable, incommunicable.

Buddha, don't you see, actually was God hiding Himself under so many veils and enigmas preparing an ignorant world for a future spiritual awakening. Time which is Father moved the will further. Jesus Christ was a later instance of the Creator's will speaking to a dark existence slightly more in communication with divinity yet still impressed with the notion of suffering. This dim age could understand the Word only in parables, see only through miracles, act by sacrifice. The Christian moment forcasted a later unfolding of His will. That would be a period when eyes could see clearly beyond the miasma of a suffering vision. When man's true original blissful nature could begin recreating its order. That time is now. The Creator in human form. Visible and invisible, two worlds meet in man. Don't make the mistake again of denying His body. The Lord who created wishes us to create. If you wish to maintain your visas you must learn to serve creation as spirit and body, to relight the candle and learn to smile again. Then we can perhaps grant you a transient visa. Buddha was a transient frail flicker of the Creator's omnipotent flame. Don't annoy us with your little lights of meditation, your centuries of formless stone and incarnate sleep. The soul of men must quicken to creation. We here are seized by the divine will. Our business is revelation. If you cannot love and serve then we don't want to look upon your withered ancient face. It's your last chance, Bodhisattvas. We don't care for your prayer wheels, worship of the dead, or denial or rituals with forgotten meanings. Waste and void. Stagnation is death. If you are to evolve you must become conscious of the change of time. Come out of your sorrow, your shelters and vacant institutions. Your darkness only reminds us of the light. Awaken from the beds of the East. Knowledge has consciously apprehended your limitations, dear Buddhists. Don't try to limit others by your incapacity. Your light has failed. It was part of the plan, the Creator's will. A far brighter light is upon the face of the earth now. It is a time of knowledge and ecstasy. A positive vision is born.

Dear Jean-Paul Sartre,

Now, to come to the point, I will tell you that the Truth of Existence is being constantly revealed by the Mental Being in possession of Practical Omnipotence who is our Creator, he is called Ciranjiva, it is he who maintains all life in existence by the terrible Power of his Will, he is the Reality, he is our Father here to establish the Natural Order of Existence.

Jean-Paul Sartre, I am here to convey his message to you given the position you occupy in the relative world of colossal imbecility in which Politics have

arrived at the critical point of stupidity, Religions at the summit of hypocrisy, Science at the peak of blindness; from all sides total saturation is manifested as evidenced by this perfidious Intellect whose ardent defender you show yourself to be and which has stretched you on the rack, not only you but all who follow without understanding why in this infernal round of disorder and death.

You are very famous, Jean-Paul Sartre, in this world, dead as you can feel it to be, where neither man nor woman exists, all are dead since the apparition of radioactivity, since the idea of Profit replaced the idea of God. To survive the change you have to understand that the immortal awakening of Ciranjiva our Creator has sounded the death knell of oppressive ignorance, and is gradually effectuating itself by the self-conscious manifestation of divine forms, which he himself calls Gods and Goddesses. Communism, capitalism and other ideas which men, troubled by their incapacity of self-realization in harmony with the creation, have wished to impose on humanity, were manifested in mankind as a constantly increasing pressure persisting in the apparent divisions of a suffering and apprehensive atmosphere without ever bringing the solution for the existence of Love, Peace and Mutual Respect.

Today we are aware that these ideas no longer mean anything, that the values have changed! All these ideas attempting to revive a dead past no longer interest us, we have already experimented with them too much! So let us rather be sincere and lucid, let us open our eyes and ears to the opportune moment. Why lean toward the Left or the Right, don't you see their similarity, that one is as good as the other in spilling blood on our beautiful planet? Yes, all that is relative, but remember it is he, the Father, who created Relativity, and what a great idiot is he who compares the Creator with his creations; he is the Divine Knowledge, the rest is your destruction.

It is time at last that you realize how many human beings had only suicide as a goal after reading your books, which offered only absurd views on this existence, beautiful as it is; you are a dead man kept alive by these ideas of death which you proliferated, but happily for you God is Indulgence and Understanding and your only saving grace is to write the life of our Creator, given your profession as man of letters:

Jean-Paul Sartre, you have written the life of Stalin and that ran to thousands of pages... Why not write my life? I am Ciranjiva, your creator. If not, you are dead like Jean-Luc Godard. I will destroy all things, the things which are created by the limelight of a propaganda machine in a world of ignorance and which you think to be worse than you. But you can fool some of the people all the time and all of the people some of the time, and you can just fool yourself until you die as a physical sensation of formal existence. Look at Jean-Luc Godard, ground meat, do you understand that, Jean-Paul Sartre? What do you want with Hell? As you understand it, the existence shows it to us. You ask the French people to succumb to the war machine or the industrual machine--real political imbecility --lead by the decadence of Pompidou. Right? Scorning my gods, Frank and Jean-Louis, you understand, you French leaders of literature, intellect and politics! You have produced nothing but sexual impotence.

I love you, I don't blame the ignorance with which you are covered, we all will pass beyond it, the important thing is the experience acquired; how could one blame ignorance and falsehood since they have no real existence! They are born of Truth and we are the children of Truth, and all that is our own imagination, don't you realize that? I am sending you the documents with Siva Kalpa included written by Ciranjiva for the service of humanity; the Words speak for themselves, we have realized the significance of the words, so you, Jean-Paul Sartre, as a man of letters you can only do the same, rediscovering your divinity at the Source of Knowledge, and as you can understand, renew your visa of physicality.

I await a prompt reply from you to 5 Blvd. Albe, St. Just, 13 Marseille 13th, manifesting your position in light of the Self-Conscious Revelation of Truth. I remain at your service for further communication for the purpose of helping the entire humanity suffering the most critical period of its existence.
