REPORT FROM HEADQUARTERS:

Dear Family -- B.S.B. and greetings! Good News. Richard, Philippe, Cherise and myself have spring in our hearts, and have begun our "spring cleaning" here in 65 #5. Order has begun. The main roon, off the kitchen, has been established as the music roon of Scott Street. It is very simple, with two flat beds, on a carpet (gift from Christina), an oval table, the stand of which is shaped like the veena, the instrument pictured with Saraswati. There is a stereo system for playing records to learn music and dance. Above the fire place is a picture of Siva, in who's honor I am creating this room. We were graced with Father's presence the evening of February 20th after our first musical dhuni, and listened to a pre-dawn to sunrise raga named "Raga Aheer Bhairow", played by Ali Akbar Khan, Sarod, and Mahapurush Misra, Tabla. It is a raga written in worship of Siva. And oddly enough, if I might add, the first one for me to hear and remember the melody.

Father sat between Sarada and myself and beat the rhythm on my knee. He first taught me how to play the tamboura during the musical rehearsals of "The Dance of Durga". I have recently asked him to teach me how to feel the rhythm as it is played on the tabla. In the forthcoming trip to India planned for May, as we gather our list of "goodies" to be brought back from there, I am requesting a tamboura, tablas, damaru, and a harmonium to be shipped, so that we may have the instruments with which to practice. In the interim, we shall be practicing here, with the instruments we have. Lou Gottlieb, who is now living in 53 Scott Street, is currently providing his home and his knowledge of music, together with Richard Bernet. I feel priviledged and honored to have them teaching the art of music The music room is open to anyone who feels to practice. Also, in the evenings, dancing is being practiced after dinner. Fourthly, if Danny hadn't called in reply to my telegram, we would not have known that Ganga and he had a baby boy, Kim Vayu on Thursday, Feb. 9.

The Foundation of Revelation 59 Scott Street, San Francisco February 13, 1978

Dear Mr. Barehan,

On Friday, February 10 I applied for tourist visas for myself, my son Jonathan and Mr. Ciranjiva Roy to visit friends in Australia for one month. Because Mr. Roy is the minister for the Foundation of Revelation, Inc., a world-wide spiritual organization, we were interviewed by Mr. Duncan. Due to the nature of Mr. Duncan's questions I feel I did not fully represent the position and function of the Foundation and somehow I created a misunderstanding of our work and activities. The Foundation was incorporated in San Francisco in January of 1970 as a basis from which to serve the community, the country and the world at large. Since then Foundation headquarters have been organized in Los Angeles, Littleton, Co., Minneapolis and Rochester, N.Y. in this country and in Australia, England, France, Belgium, Holland and India by members of those respective countries. Individually we are dedicated to improving social, economic and political conditions in our respective communities. As an international association we have contributed to the improvement of international relations by hosting people from all over the world and providing a basis for mutual appreciation of and respect for the diverse cultures of the world.

In the winter of 1976 we organized a Food Co-operative to serve our neighborhood, not just those people belonging to our organization, but all our neighbors. Our purpose was to provide good produce at reasonable prices and a convenient location. In two years we have increased our assets several hundred percent and are expanding our service. In the spring of the same year we organized a neighborhood assocation, the Duboce Environmental Village Association, to improve neighborhood conditions and gain a voice in local government. In June we were granted \$4500 by the Neighborhood Initiative Improvement Project to build a play structure in our local park. In August we were commended by the San Francisco Beautiful Assocation for our work in turning a vacant lot into a neighborhood garden. In October we were awarded an additional \$8,000 by the Bicentennial Awards Committee to continue our work in the parks. Individually we have improved the buildings we live in and have upgraded conditions in our neighborhood, which was a near slum when we began our work eight years ago.

During the summer of 1976 we hosted approximately two hundred visitors from England, France, Belgium, Holland, Australia and India for three months, including parents of our members from the respected business community. All expressed their deep appreciation

for our hospitality and issued invitations for us to visit them in their respective countries. Among our guests were Mr. and Mrs. Geoffrey Brock, parents of the Australian race car champion, Peter Brock. In the spring of 1975 Mr. Roy visited Australia with the Foundation President, Charlotte P. Wallace, and returned with high praise for the warm and industrious nature of the Australians he met.

Mr. Duncan asked at some length my opinions on drugs which I answered truthfully. Neither myself nor Mr. Roy personally, nor the Foundation as a whole has any involvement in drug traffic or drug legislation. I expressed my personal views on the subject but I am not personally dedicated to this particular problem. We have helped many people suffering from drug related problems as well as marital, financial and social problems since these are what we are all faced with at this time. I can provide you with corroboration of our activities from Mr. Peter Ashe, Director of Recreation for the city of San Francisco, State Assemblyman Willie Brown and City Supervisor, Harvey Milk. Further information can be obtained from Ms. Wallace here in San Francisco at the above address and phone number and from Mrs. Daniel Hennenberg, President of the Australian Foundation, 854 Toorak Road, East Hawthorn, Victoria, Australia.

Our tickets were pre-paid, sixty days in advance by the Australian Foundation and are not subject to change of date. Our departure is scheduled for February 22, so I would appreciate hearing your decision or request for further information as soon as possible. I have cabled the Australian Foundation about our problem, so ou should be hearing from them as well.

Thank you for your attention. I hope this helps resolve whatever misapprehensions you may have received about our organization. We are not affiliated with nor resemble in any way such organizations as the Unification Church, the Hare Krishnas, etc., and it is our sincerest aspiration to create and maintain good relations with whomever we associate. I hope this will give you grounds to reconsider our applications, as our inabliity to travel to Australia will greatly disappoint those who visited us here and invited us to your country.

(Editor's note: On February 17th, after a phone conversation with a Mr. Duncan who was answering for Mr. Bareham at the Australian Consulate, John Morton called the following people on behalf of Caroline Grey: State Assemblyman Willie Brown, Senator Alan Cranston, Herb Caen of the San Francisco Chronicle, San Francisco City Supervisor Harvey Milk, Congressman John Burton, State Senator Milton Marks. Those who could be reached were kind to look into the matter, but all responded that there was very little that could be done through the American government at this time. It was definitely Australia'a decision and they said "NO". Two phone conversations with Danny Hennenberg revealed that he had contacted a minister of the "shadow government" in Australia but could get no immediate relief. The following letter completes the file on this matter to date.)

> Global Travel Service San Francisco Feb. 27, 1978

Civil Aeronautic Board Dear Sirs:

Our clients Mr. C. Roy, Miss C. Grey and her son were not able to use their \$2,400 tickets issued by Pan American in San Francisco and pre-paid in Melborne because our clients were not allowed visas into Australia. They applied two weeks before their departure date and were not given a reason for the denial. There was no reason to believe that Mr. Roy and his companions would not be granted visas as he traveled to Melborne in the spring of 1975. I appreciate your looking into this injustice.

help me i pray you


